Application Process

Students can apply to Keystone International School as of Grade 7. Admissions are on a rolling basis. Students seeking admission at Grade 12 level are assessed on a case-by-case basis and are required to present recommendation letters.

1. Submit your application

- Application Form along with fee
- Birth Certificate/Passport
- Transcripts/Report Cards for the previous 3 years
- 2. Schedule your interview
- 3. Pay fees

Minimum Language Requirements

Grades 7 - 9

CEFR: A2 IELTS: 3+ TOEFL: 30 Grade 10 & 11

CEFR: B1 IELTS: 4.5 TOEFL: 34-36 Grade 12

CEFR: B2+ IELTS: 5.5+ TOEFL: 46+

If you have not taken any recognized language test, placement tests will be administered by Keystone International Schools via our online platform.

ESL Support

At Keystone, students will be enrolled in the appropriate ESL level course based on their results. All ESL courses count towards the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. Students will also be enrolled in other courses based on their language abilities.

Credit Equivalencies

All student transcripts will be examined and equivalent credits will be granted based on previous schooling.

Compulsory courses may be substituted with ESL courses as per need. All courses are compulsory in Grades 7&8.



Admission to Keystone

Once all the required document are submitted, the interview and the placement tests are completed, it will take typically 3-5 school days to review the application. Students will be communicated by email to communicate the decision.

Students who are offered admission, will receive their offer along with their Academic Plan.

They are required to confirm their offer within 30 days or may lose their spot.

Applying for Student Visa

In order to apply for the student visa, students will need to have the following documents:

- Letter of Acceptance
- Letter of Explanation
- Proof of Funds
- Notarized Custodianship Form
- Homestay Arrangements
